RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA):

is a process for:

- Adults who are not baptized and wish to become members of the Roman Catholic Church.
- Christians baptized into a non-Catholic Church who wish to become members of the Roman Catholic Church.
- Adult Catholics, baptized as infants in the Roman Catholic Church who have not received the sacrament of Confirmation and/or Eucharist.

MARRIAGES:

The Sacrament of Marriage requires a time of spiritual preparation. Couples planning to be married are asked to make an appointment with one of the priests to set a wedding date and to begin preparations before the wedding according to N.J. Bishops Guidelines.

CELEBRATION OF CHILDREN'S BAPTISM:

Parents are requested to contact the Rectory to make arrangements. Date and time can be arranged with the priest.

SICK CALLS:

GODPARENT / SPONSOR ELIGIBILITY

Canon (Church) Law states that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, fully-initiated Catholic. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly, by a judge, mayor or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor). Please note that we can only write Letters of Eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

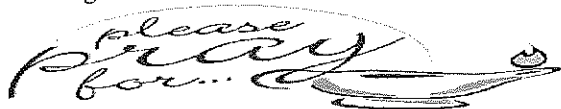

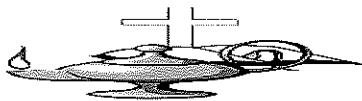

IMPORTANT-None of us need to be reminded of how our lives have changed since the beginning of March. It has been a time of uncertainty, rethinking how we do things, fear, challenges, despair with the loss of life and illness and the list could go on. We have been through our Church closing and not being able to receive the Holy Eucharist. We have had to reschedule First Holy Communion and Confirmation and limit how many could attend to celebrate these special moments. The CCD program had to switch from in person to virtual. We have had to adjust as the state and Archdiocese issued their rules and regulations. These unprecedented times were truly challenging and at times it did not seem like we would ever be able to do these things again but we persevered. We waited for the Lord to guide us and our churches are open, we are receiving Communion, sacraments have been celebrated and we are getting ready to start CCD classes.

As Fr. Luke evaluated how the CCD program has evolved over the years, with all the changes that are happening as a result of COVID-19 and after much prayer and reflection, he has decided to hire a part time Director of Religious Education. This person will replace the two coordinator positions and be responsible for all aspects of the Religious Education program and moving the program through this time of virtual instruction and forward to a stronger and more robust program for the children of Christ the King.

As you know Jane and Carmaletta have been the joint coordinators of the CCD program. Jane has been in this position for 4 years and Carmaletta recently accepted the position. Both have done so much for the program no matter the length of time in the position. Their commitment to helping the children of Christ the King grow closer to the Lord is a testament to the strength of their own faith. We can never thank them enough for all they did for the CCD program-staff, children and their families. The CCD program and in fact, the entire parish, needs their continued support and involvement.

The new Director of Religious Education is Mr. Justin F. Bejar. He is a parishioner of Christ the King and a graduate from Seton Hall University with a Masters in Biology. Justin went through the CCD program here, was a member of the CK CYO and has been a catechist. He knows our program, parish and having just gone through our CCD program, he will know what we have done that may not have worked as well as we thought or what we did that really impacted the youth in the program. We are very excited to have Justin lead us through these crazy times and look forward to working with him to make the CCD program stronger and better.

The CCD program is ALL about what we can do to help the children of our parish come to know, love and serve Jesus. This is why the CCD staff volunteers their time to prepare lessons, teach our children and set examples by attending and participating in Mass and other liturgical services. Change is not easy and we have all gone through many changes in the past six months. Please continue to pray for the CCD staff and children as we get ready to start the new school year on October 18th.

A NOTE FROM FATHER LUKE

27th Sunday of Ordinary Time

October 4, 2020

Liturgy Readings: *Isaiah 5:1-7; Psalm 80:9,12-16,19-20; Philippians 4:6-9; Matthew 21:33-43*

In an ideal household, family members know the rules and follow them consistently. Even the most conscientious among us, however, sometimes needs to be reminded of the rules and their importance. How we respond to such correction reveals our true character. In today's Gospel Jesus exposes the religious leaders for their failure to heed God's messengers. It is an opportunity for us to consider how we respond to those who are God's messengers today, calling us to correct our ways and return to the way of the Lord.

As you gather as a family, talk about some of the most important rules of your household. Consider how consistently family members follow these rules. How are family members reminded when rules are not being followed? How do they respond? In today's Gospel Jesus corrects the religious leaders through a parable telling them that they have not heeded God's messengers. After reading the Gospel, we should ask ourselves: what are some of God's rules that we must follow? How do we respond to God's messengers today? Pray together as a family that you will heed God's messengers and follow God's ways. Pray together the Act of Contrition for the times when your family has not heeded God's word.

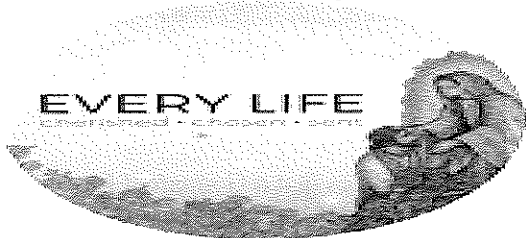


REFLECTION

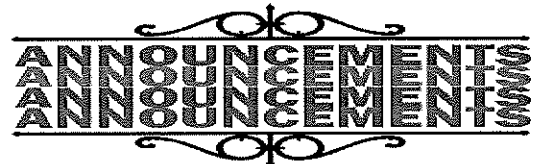
