RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA):

is a process for:

- Adults who are not baptized and wish to become members of the Roman Catholic Church.
- Christians baptized into a non-Catholic Church who wish to become members of the Roman Catholic Church.
- Adult Catholics, baptized as infants in the Roman Catholic Church who have not received the sacrament of Confirmation and/or Eucharist.

MARRIAGES:

The Sacrament of Marriage requires a time of spiritual preparation. Couples planning to be married are asked to make an appointment with one of the priests to set a wedding date and to begin preparations before the wedding according to N.J. Bishops Guidelines.

CELEBRATION OF CHILDREN'S BAPTISM:

Parents are requested to contact the Rectory to make arrangements. Date and time can be arranged with the priest.

SICK CALLS:

GODPARENT / SPONSOR ELIGIBILITY

Canon (Church) Law states that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, fully-initiated Catholic. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly, by a judge, mayor or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor). Please note that we can only write Letters of Eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

SUNDAY OF DIVINE MERCY - APRIL 24, 2022

Liturgy Readings: Acts. 5:12-16; Ps. 118:2-4,13-15,22-24; Rev. 1:9-11a,12-13,17-19; John 20:19-31

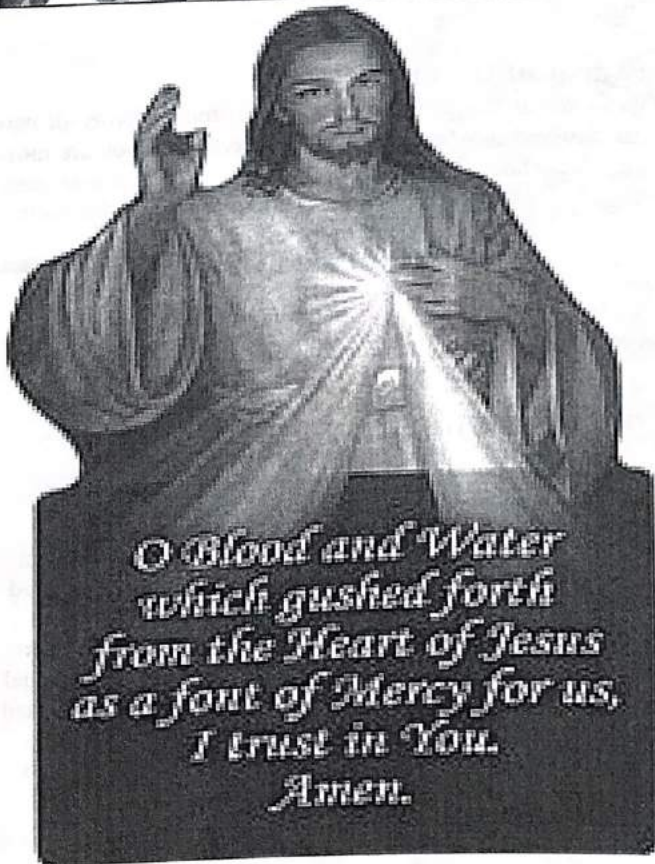
Our family life would no doubt be enhanced if we were able to transform Jesus' greeting into a central feature in our family's interactions. After His Resurrection, "Peace be with you" is the first thing that Jesus says to His disciples. This could be our daily family prayer for one another. In today's Gospel, we also hear that Jesus next breathed on His disciples and gave them the gift of the Holy Spirit. In Baptism, each of us has received the gift of the Holy Spirit as well as the forgiveness of sins.

After reading the Gospel, discuss the two gifts Jesus gave to His disciples: *peace* and the *Holy Spirit*. *What were the disciples to do with these gifts? (They were sent as Jesus was sent by the Father to forgive sins.)* Recall that we have each received Jesus' gift of the Holy Spirit at our Baptism and that peace is a fruit of the Holy Spirit. Observe that since we also have received these gifts from Christ, we are also sent to be people who forgive others as Jesus taught. Determine an action that your family can do to share peace and forgiveness with one another.

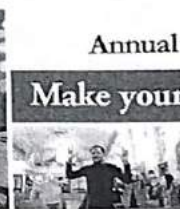

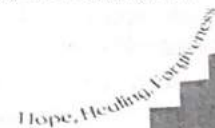

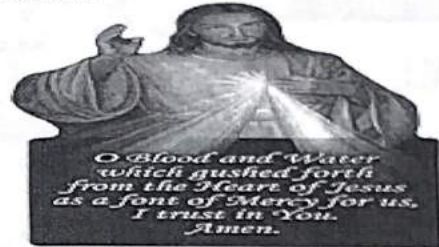

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

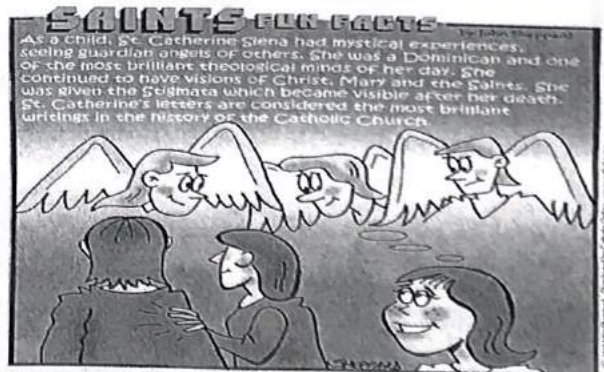
